

# 2010 Funding Priorities

## Sutter Roseville Medical Center Foundation



### *The Mission*

Trusted and respected healthcare is one pillar of a thriving community. Our mission is to cultivate partners and resources to provide state-of-the-art medical services for our community with dignity and compassion. We envision Sutter Roseville Medical Center as the premier regional medical center in our area, where patients, staff and community unite to attain excellence in healthcare.

### *Partnering*

The Foundation does not directly operate health service programs, but instead serves as the conduit for gathering needed financial support for programs and capital projects at Sutter Roseville Medical Center. One-hundred percent (100%) of the dollars raised are directed to programs within the medical center, serving the health needs of the South Placer communities.

### *Ways to Give*

Donors who partner with Sutter Roseville Medical Center Foundation may participate in a variety of ways, depending on their desires and circumstances. Donations include cash contributions, or may be a part of an estate plan involving current or deferred tax-deductible gifts of appreciated assets. Unrestricted donations allow the Foundation Board to respond to current needs within the medical center, although donors may also choose to direct their contributions toward programs of personal interest. ## *Annual Projects Funded by Unrestricted Donations*

### *Cardiology Equipment Purchases—\$100,000*

Improve our cardiac patients' over all experience by funding the build-out of a new Surgical Preparation Area (SPA) within the existing Cardiac Catheterization Lab and remodeling the Cardiac Rehabilitation area to make it more usable for patients' exercise and education.

### *Orthopedic Navigation System — \$230,000*

Purchase an additional orthopedic navigation system to meet the increased need for computer-aided hip and knee replacements. This minimally-invasive surgery can be done with more precise incisions and more accurate placement of the new joint. The patient usually experiences less pain, a shorter length of stay and quicker recovery.

### *Center for Thoracic Disease — \$200,000*

More people die of lung cancer each year than from any other type of cancer - in fact, more than breast, prostate and colorectal cancers combined. This investment would help create a specialized "virtual" Center for Thoracic Disease with a dedicated Nurse Navigator and Medical Director to diagnose, treat and provide recovery for patients diagnosed with cancer and other diseases located within the chest area.

### *Sutter Rehabilitation Institute (SRI)—\$1,000,000*

The primary goal of the institute is to help patients disabled by brain or spinal cord injury, severe stroke, orthopedic or degenerative neurological disorders to achieve maximum functional independence and return back to the community. The institute opened in November 2008 and is already operating at maximum capacity. Funding would allow the final 15-bed unit and nursing station to be unshelled, along with building out space for additional support services.

*Total 2010 Funding Needs: \$ 1,530,000*
