Specialty Program Descriptions



Stroke Program

The majority of patients admitted to Sutter Rehabilitation Institute are admitted into our CARF Accredited Stroke Program. Our patients benefit from the advanced certifications of our nurses and therapists which help them achieve their goals.

Brain Injury Program

Our dedicated brain injury unit is specifically designed to meet the unique behavioral and physical needs of patients who have sustained traumatic and non-traumatic brain injuries. We accept patients at Rancho Los Amigos Scale Level IV or higher into our CARF Accredited Brain Injury Program.

Spinal Cord Injury Program

We admit traumatic and non-traumatic spinal cord injury patients with injuries at C5 and below. Patients need to be weaned from the ventilator and respiratory status must be stable. Our Spinal Cord Injury team has advanced training and is led by a Board-Certified Spinal Cord Injury Physician.

Orthopedic Program

We provide services for a variety of orthopedic conditions including but not limited to hip fractures, hip/knee replacements with medical complications, laminectomy, spinal fusions and multiple trauma with multiple fractures.

Amputation Program

Patients with new amputations benefit from intensive therapy to restore strength, mobility and self-care, as well as education and training in wound and skin care, and prevention of complications. Prosthetists work closely with therapists to ensure best fit and function. Supportive counseling is provided to assist with adjustment to disability.
